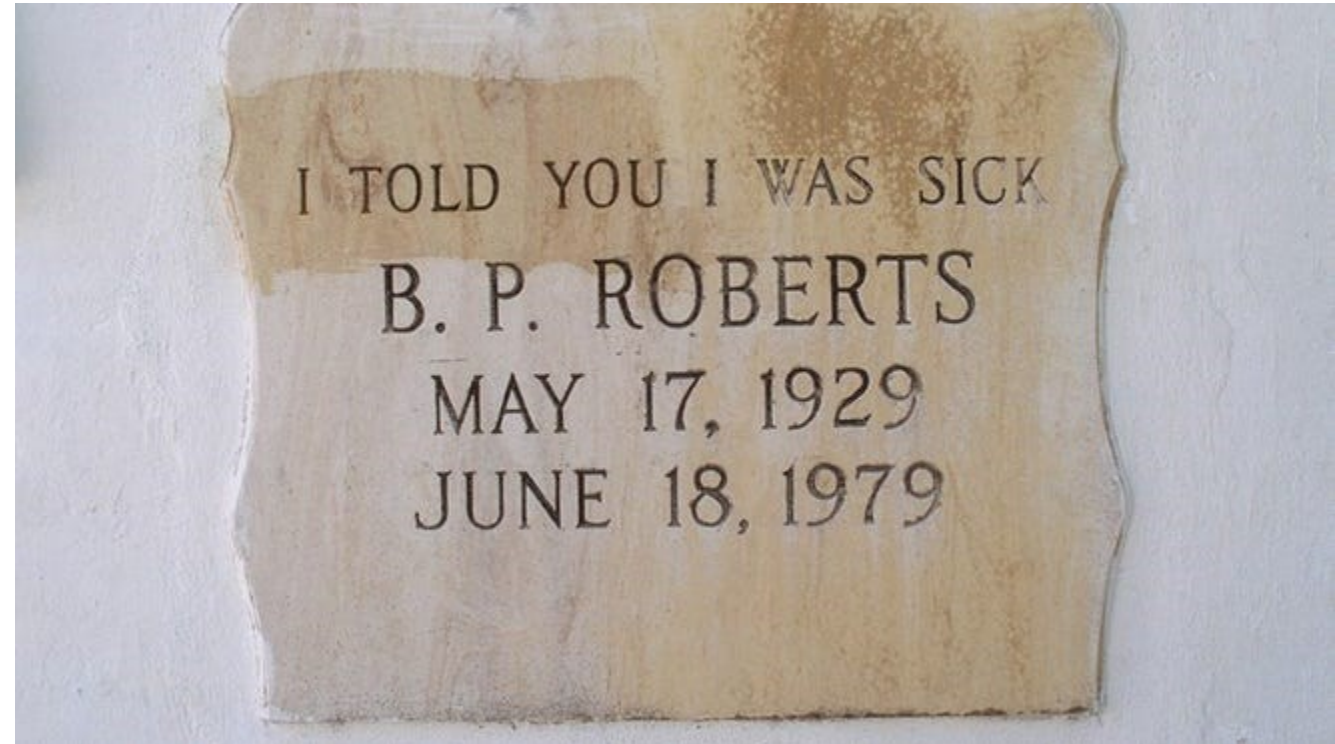
And we saw the most beautiful little deer I have ever seen – they are small and cute with their antlers! We found them on No Name Key.

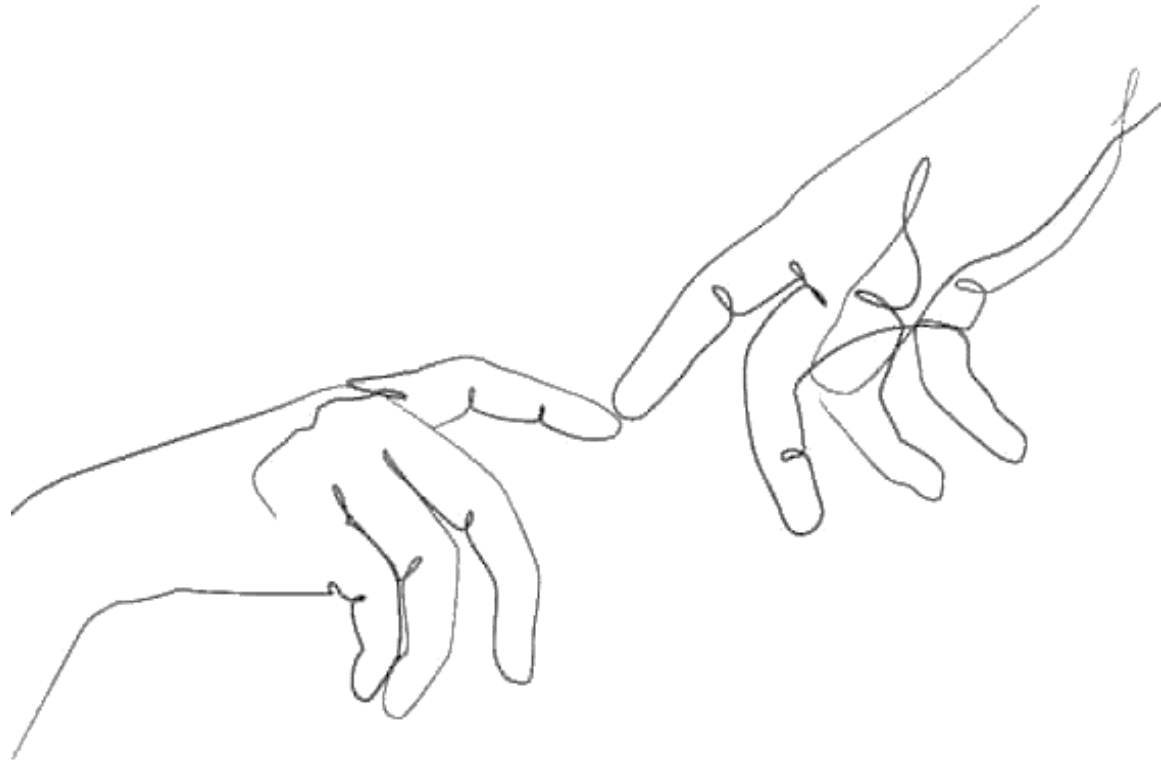


We always made sure we visited the Southern Most Point in the USA and took pictures too.
