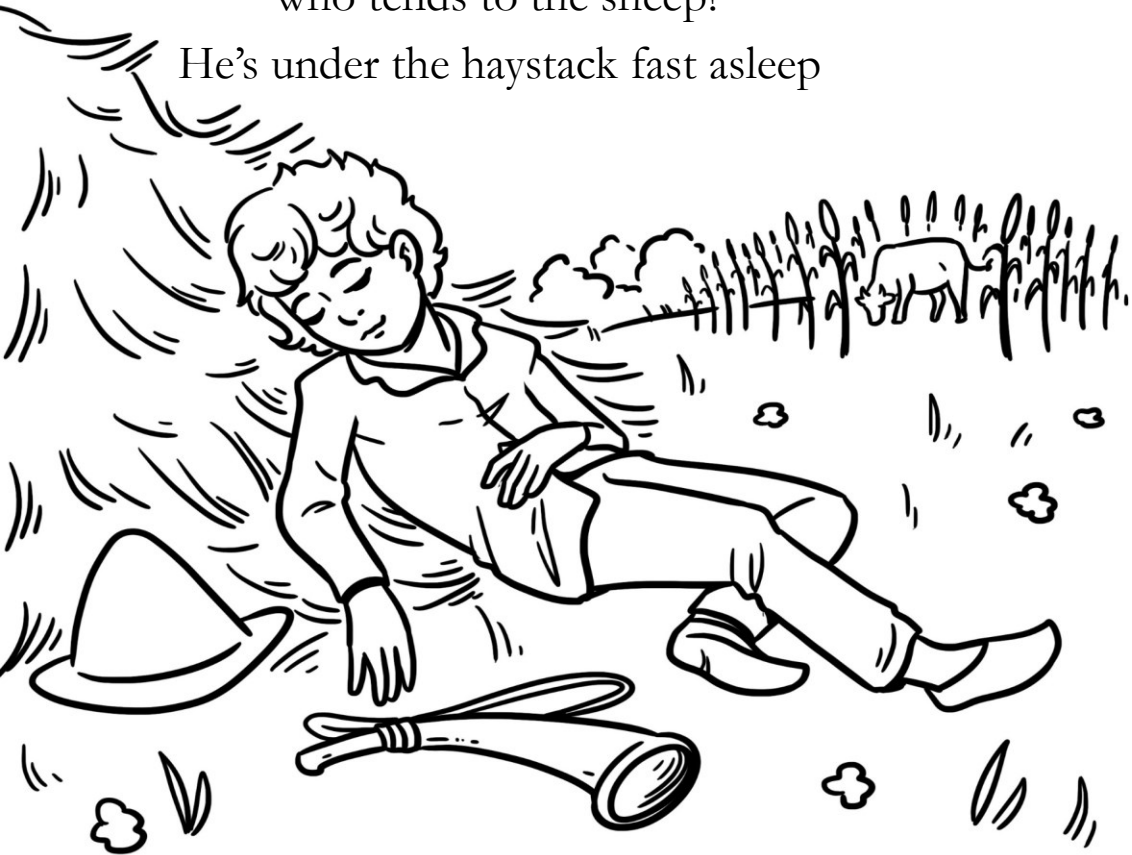

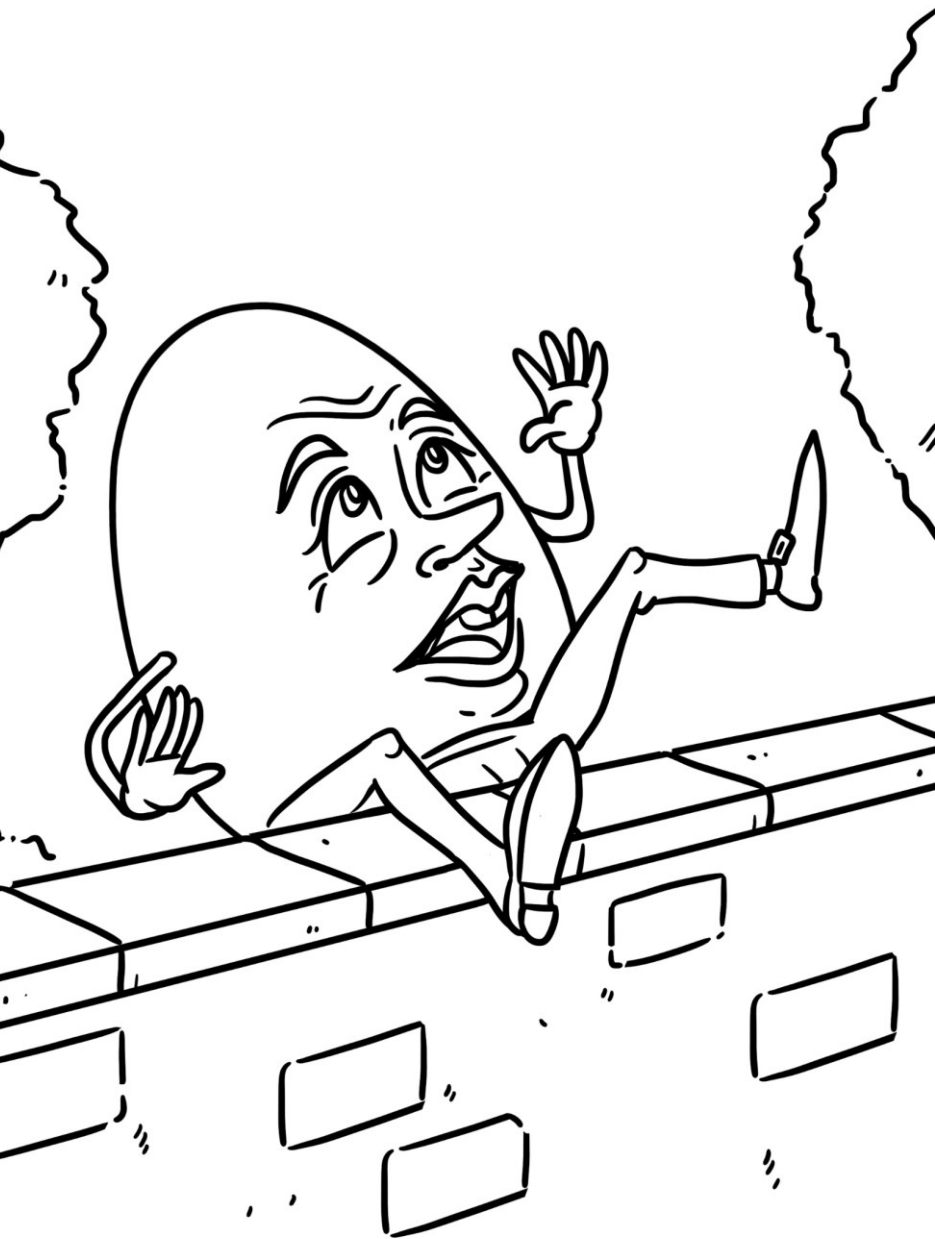

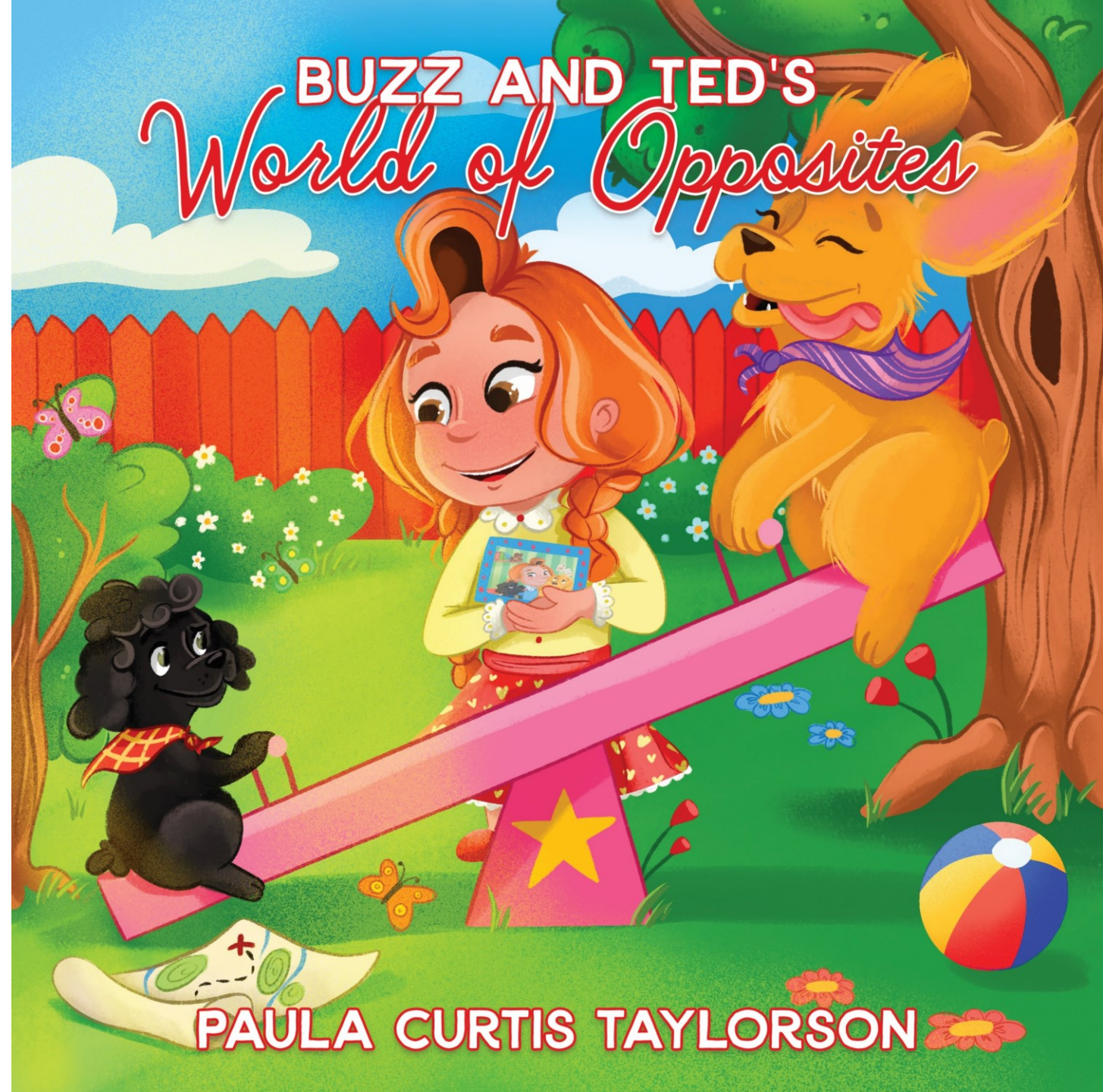

got terribly wet...



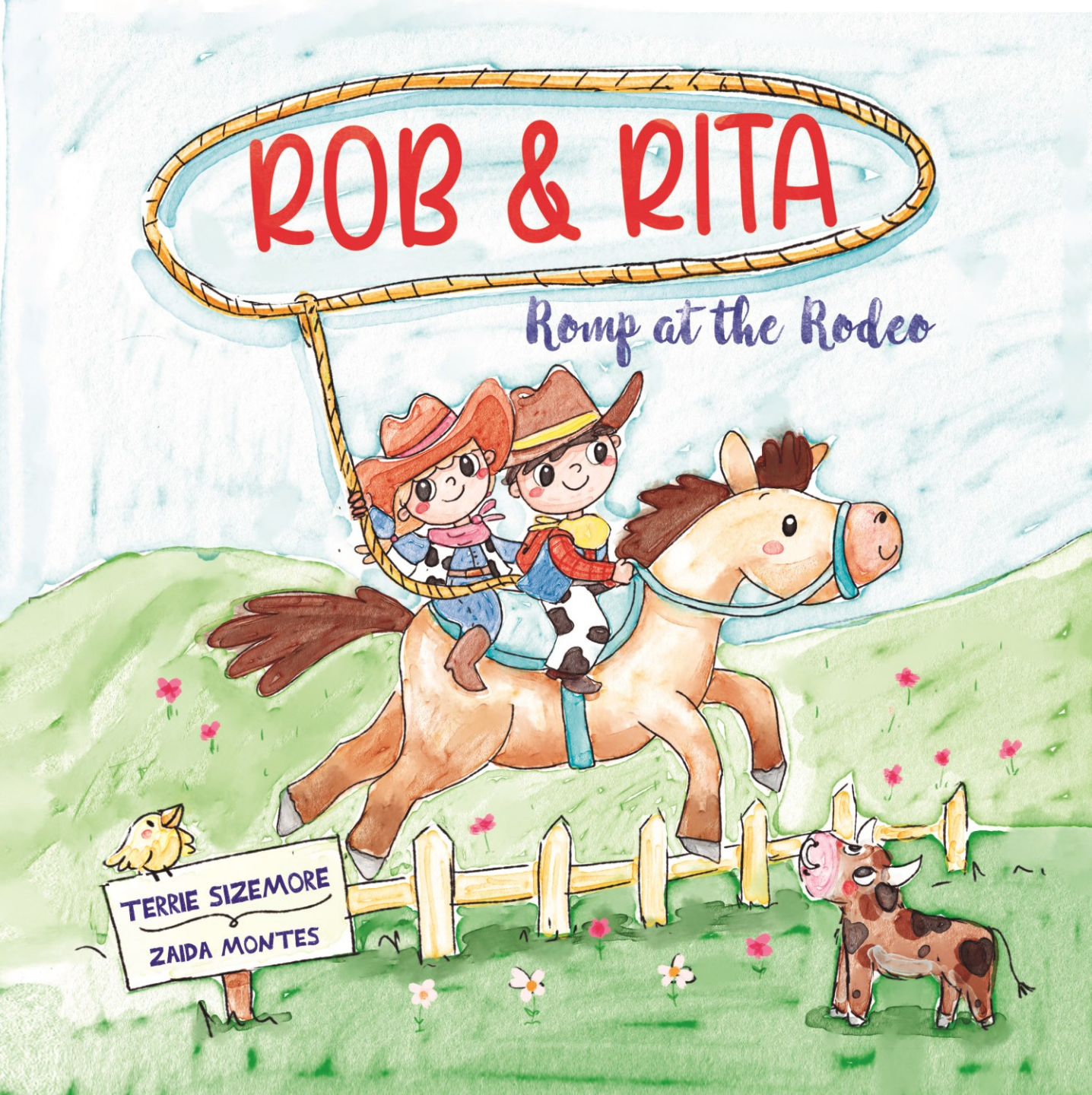
**On Wednesday, a soft

time for the Rodeo



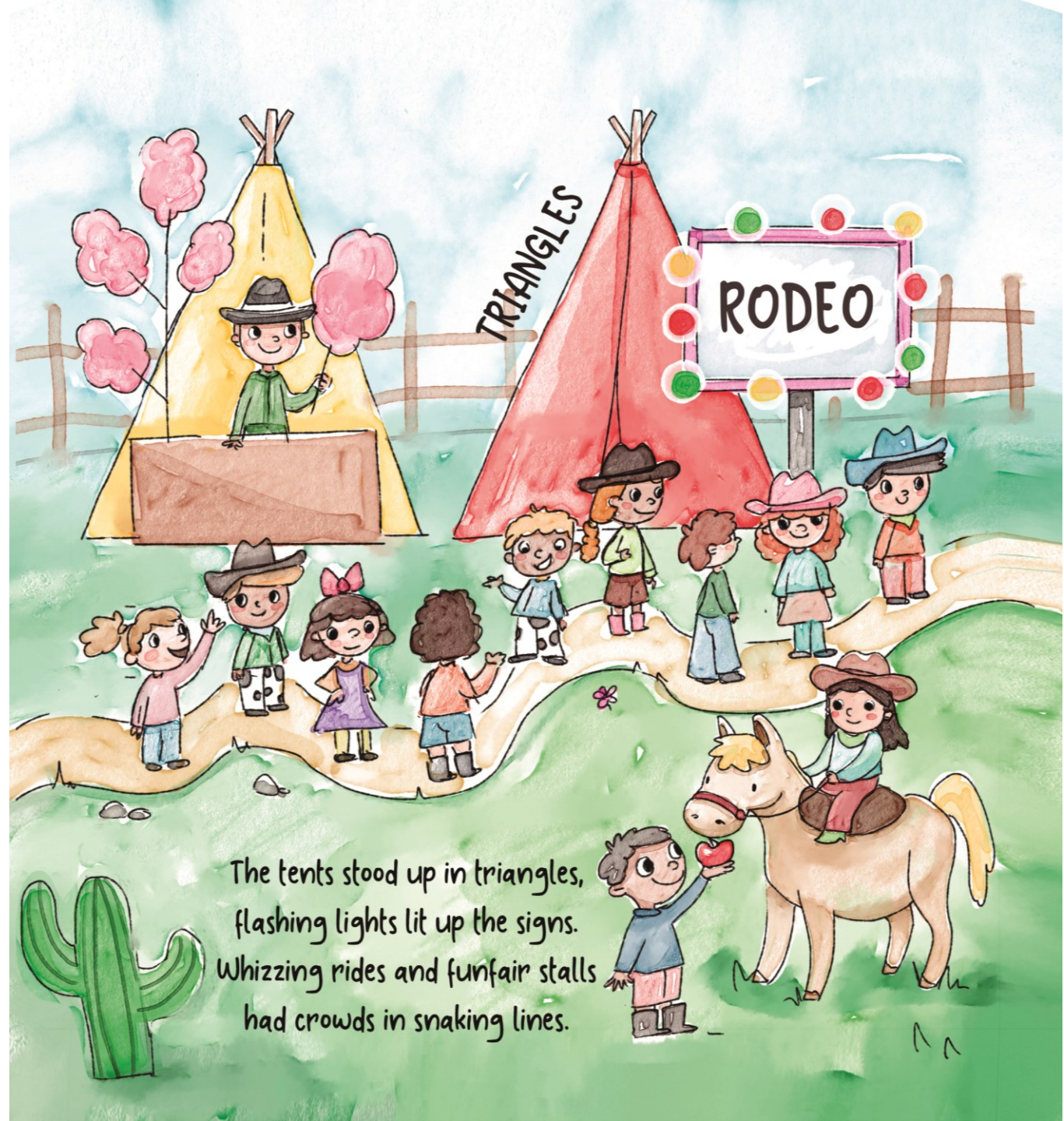
Up above the mountains, the golden sun was shining down,

They donned their cowboy hats and boots and set off to the rodeo.

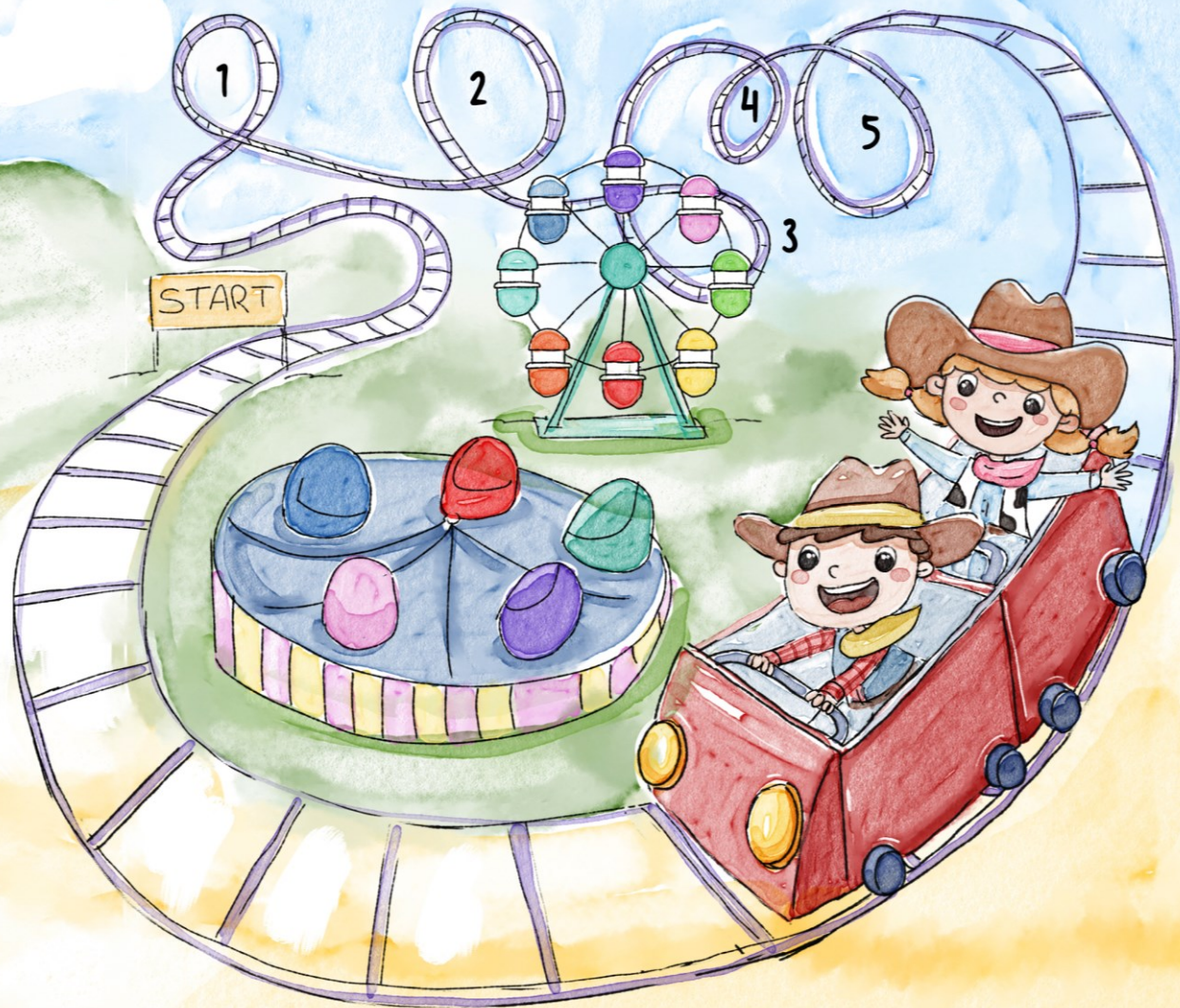


Rita and Rob get all
