Then they form a Chrysalis — which means to spin a COCOON,



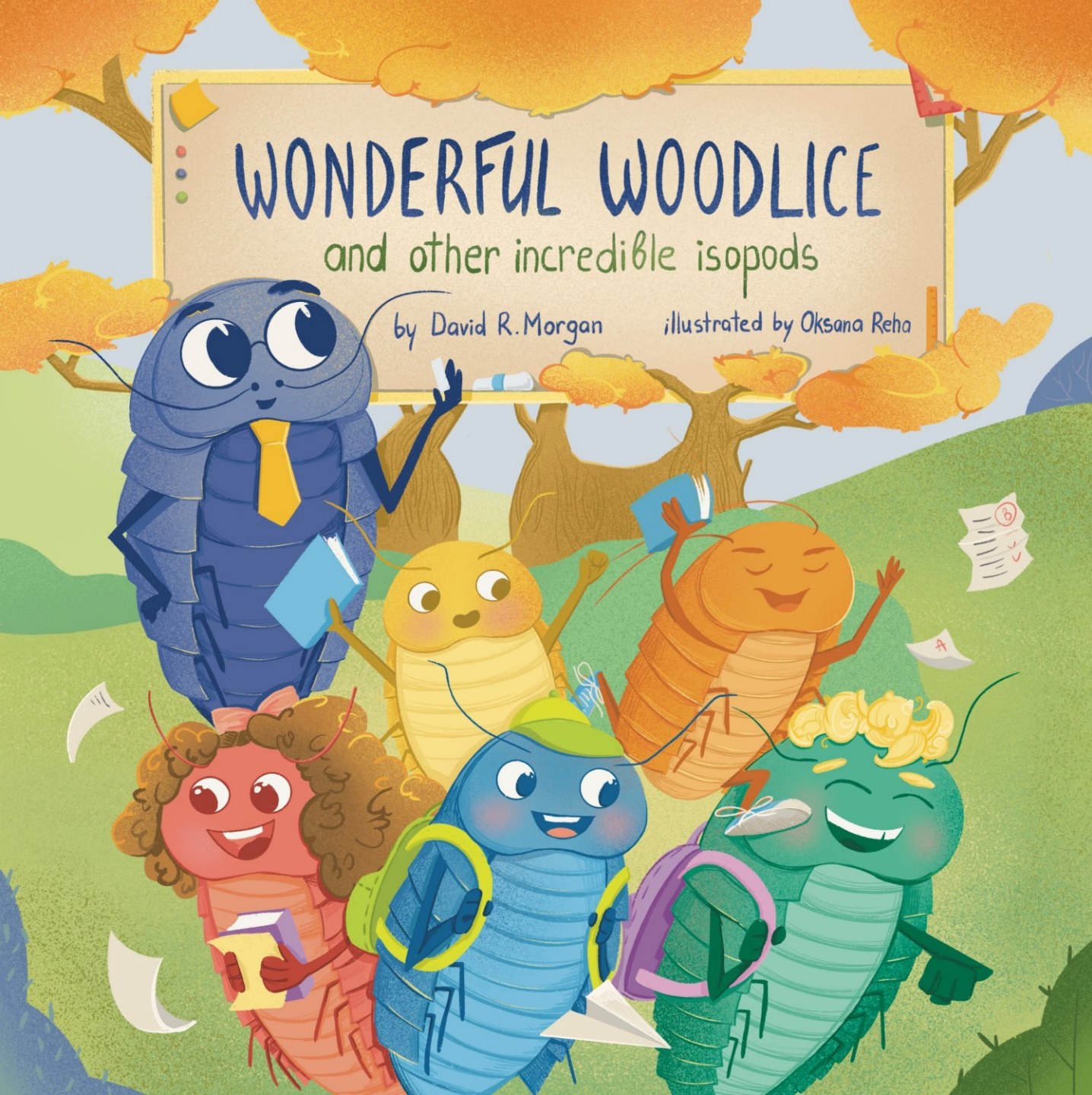
**And THEN! WOW! They are the

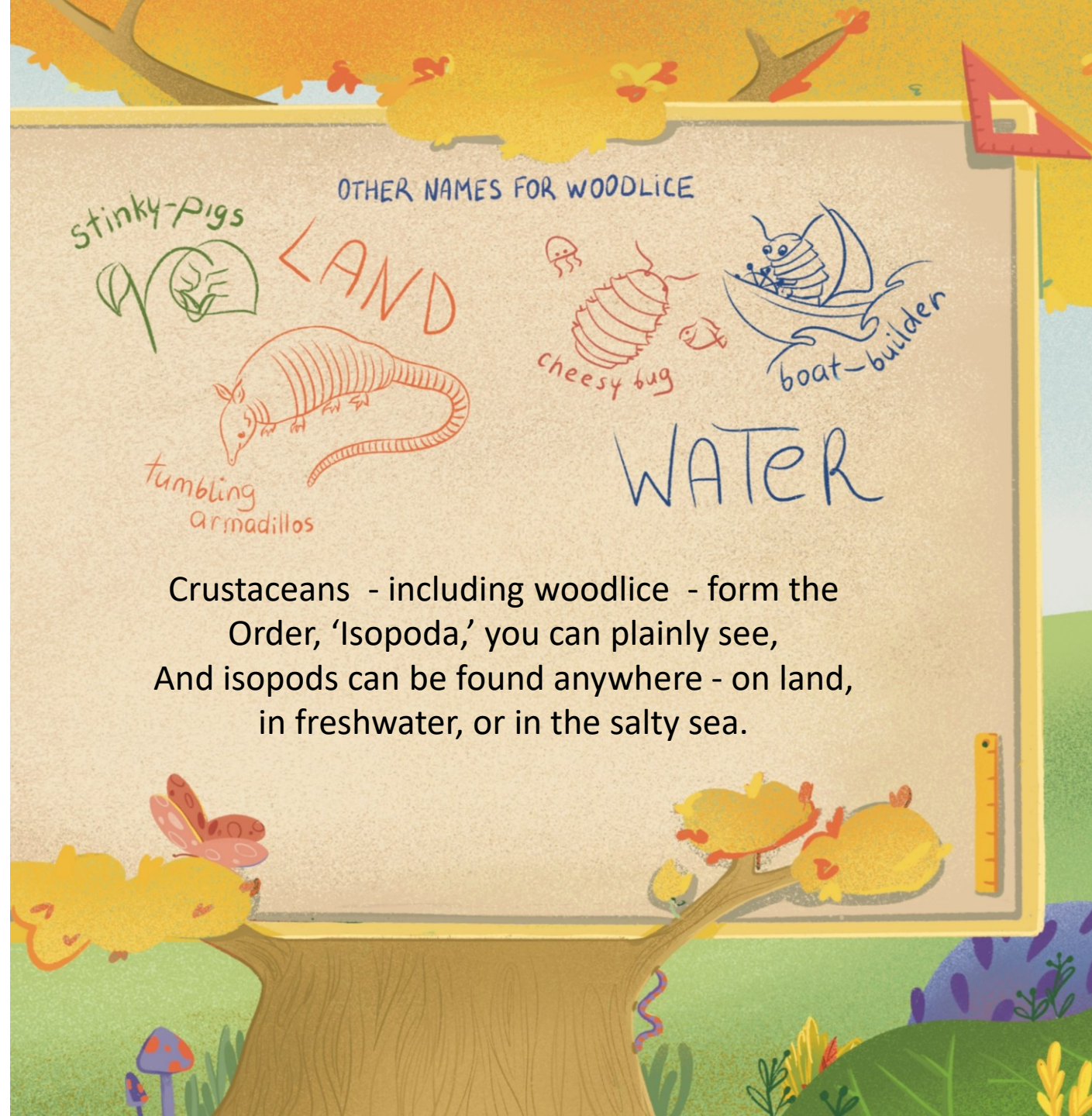




**Some of them roll into little

NO! Stones don't move that way up and down!

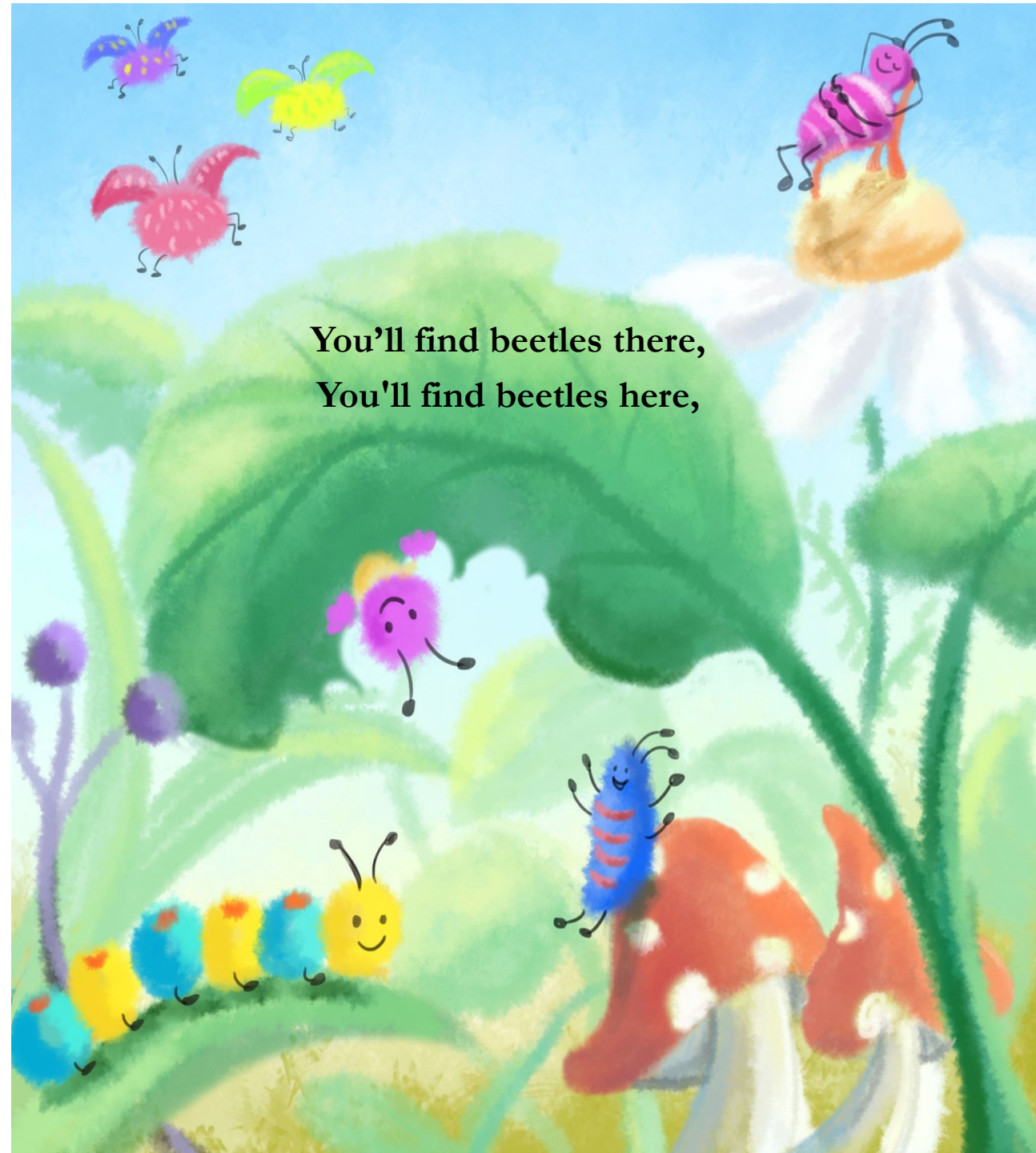


Such colorful bugs with

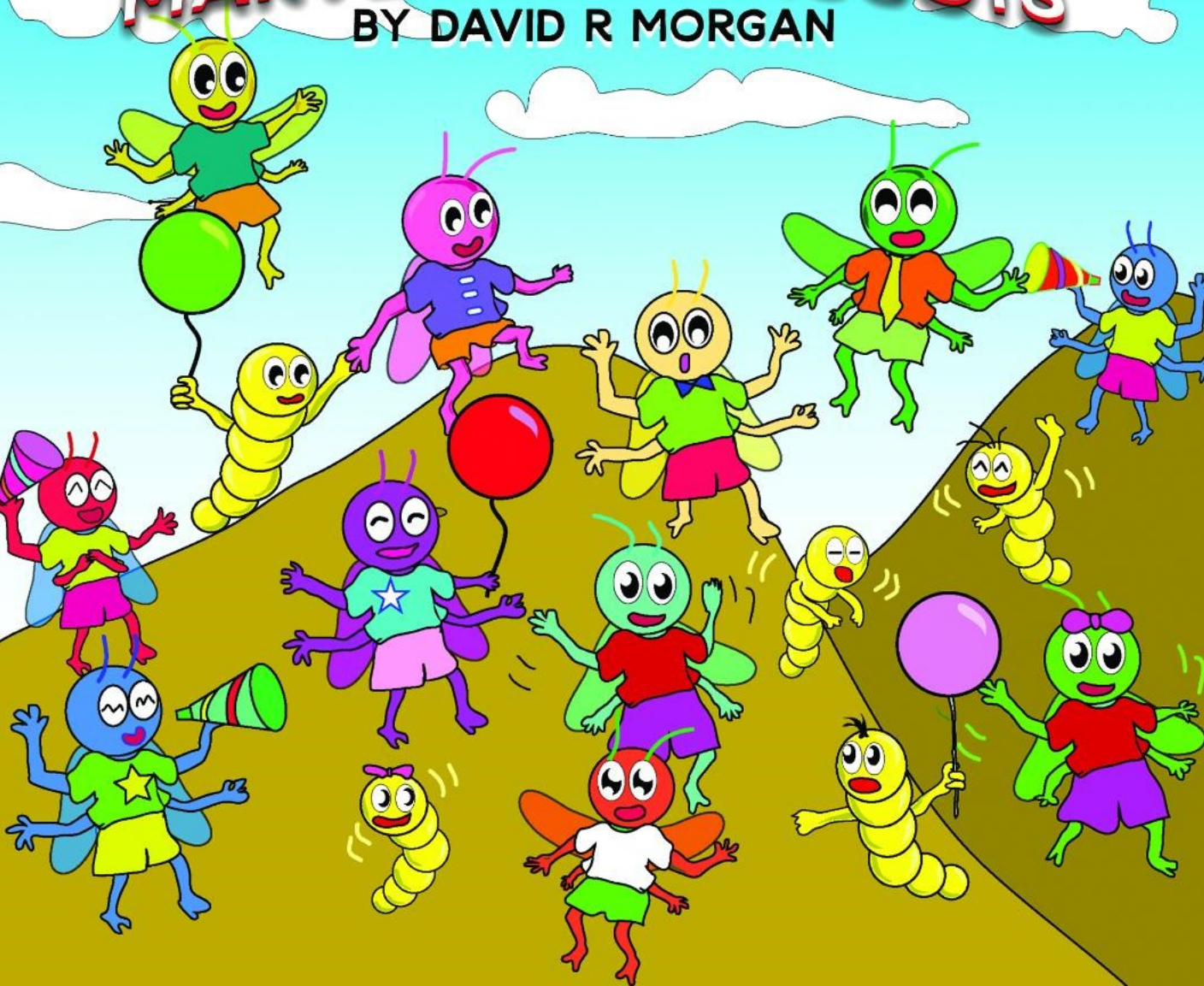

So, listen up, and I'll tell you why.



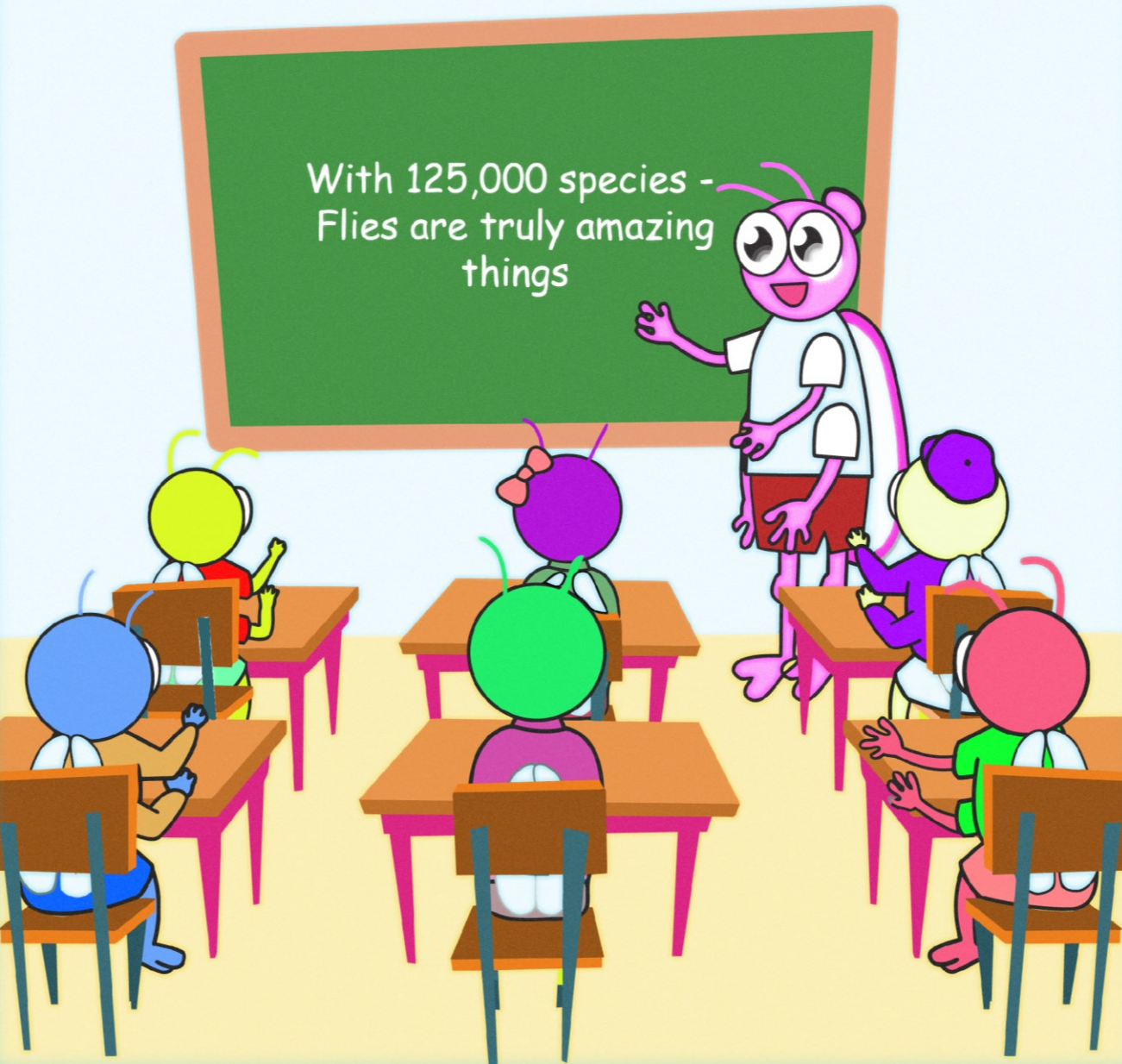

In science, we learn about their place in our world.



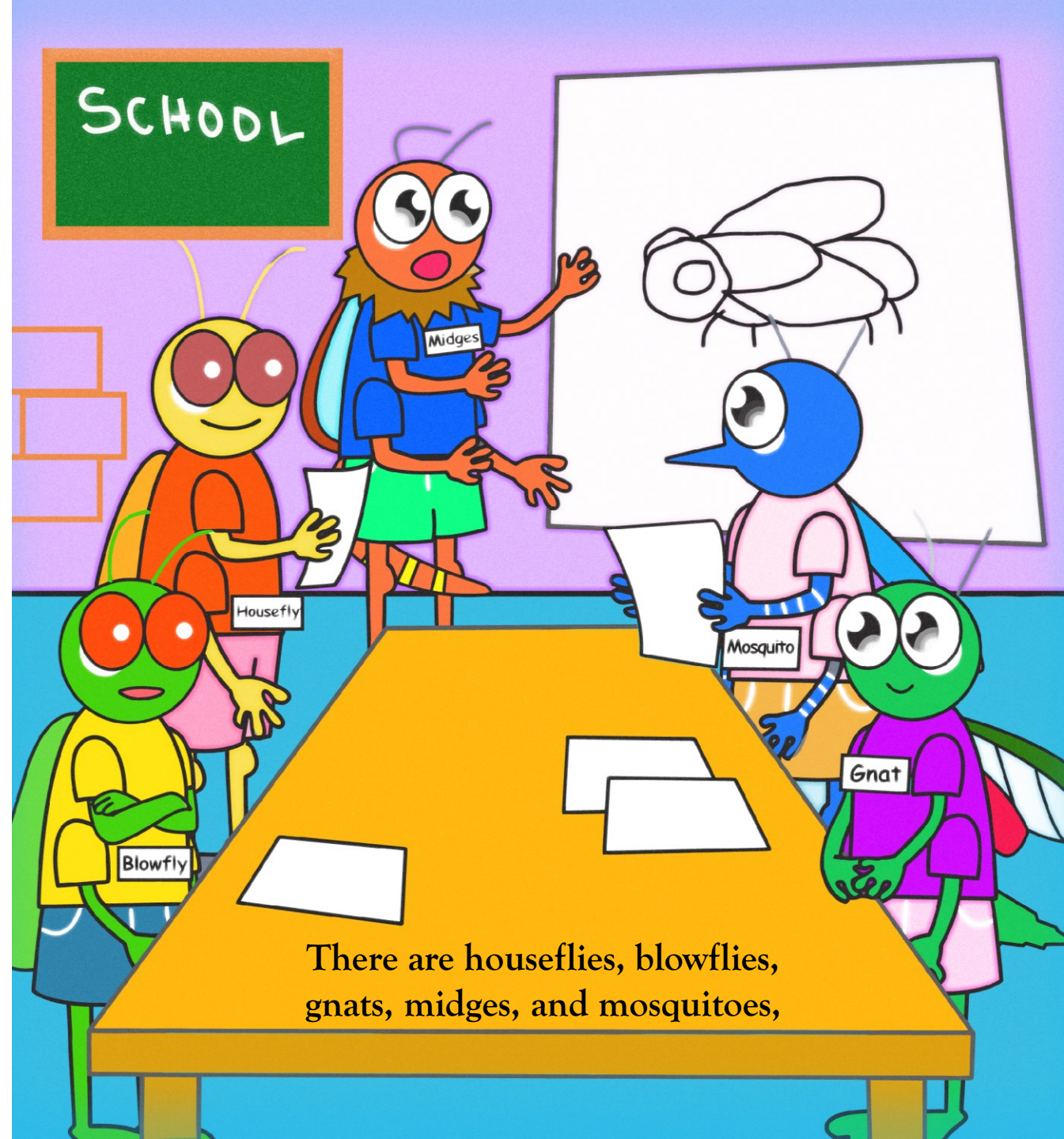
Flies belong to the Order of
