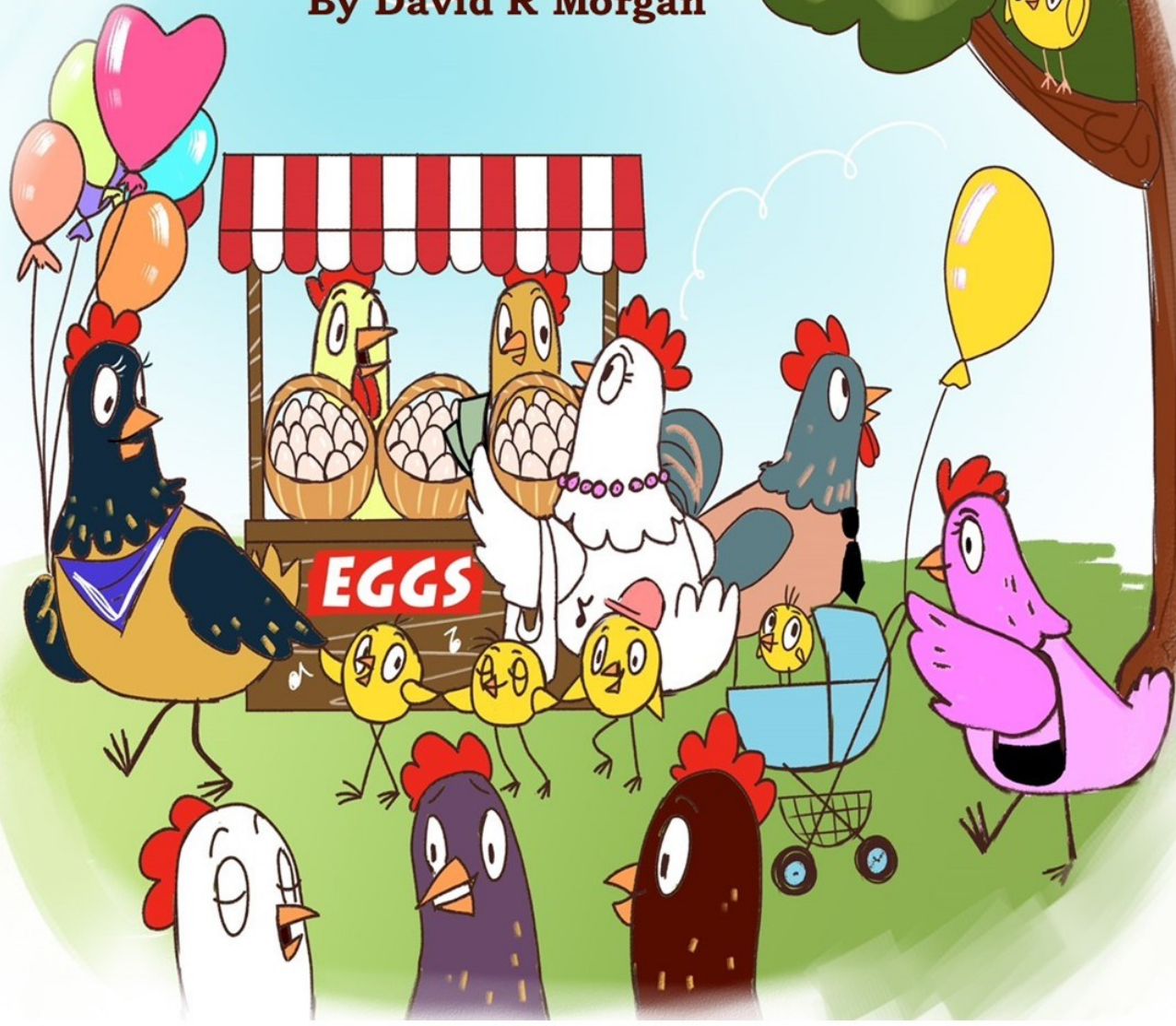

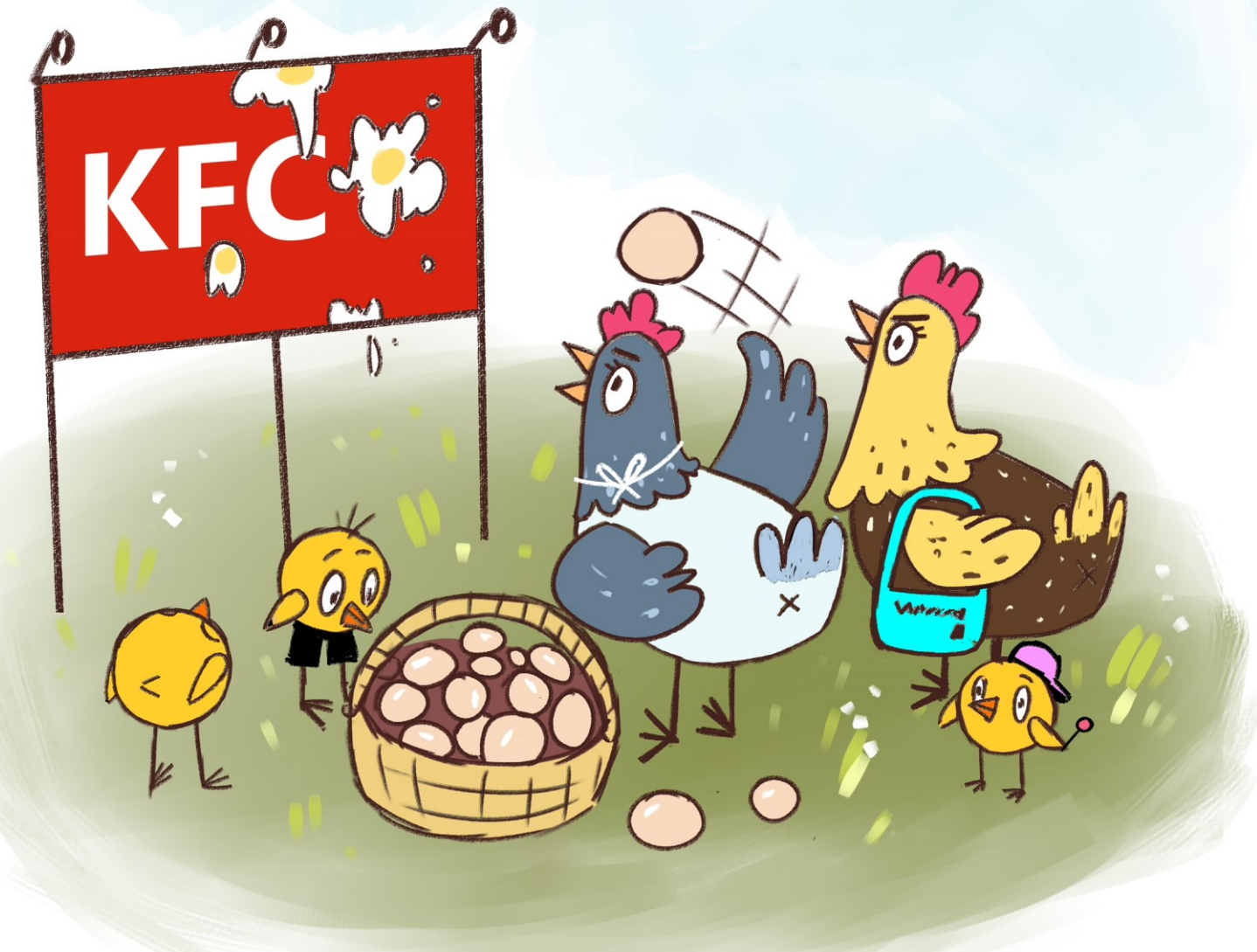


*Cheeky Chickens* is a sweet and fun little book about – you guessed it - chickens! Come, see how the hens and roosters and chicks have fun in the barnyard.

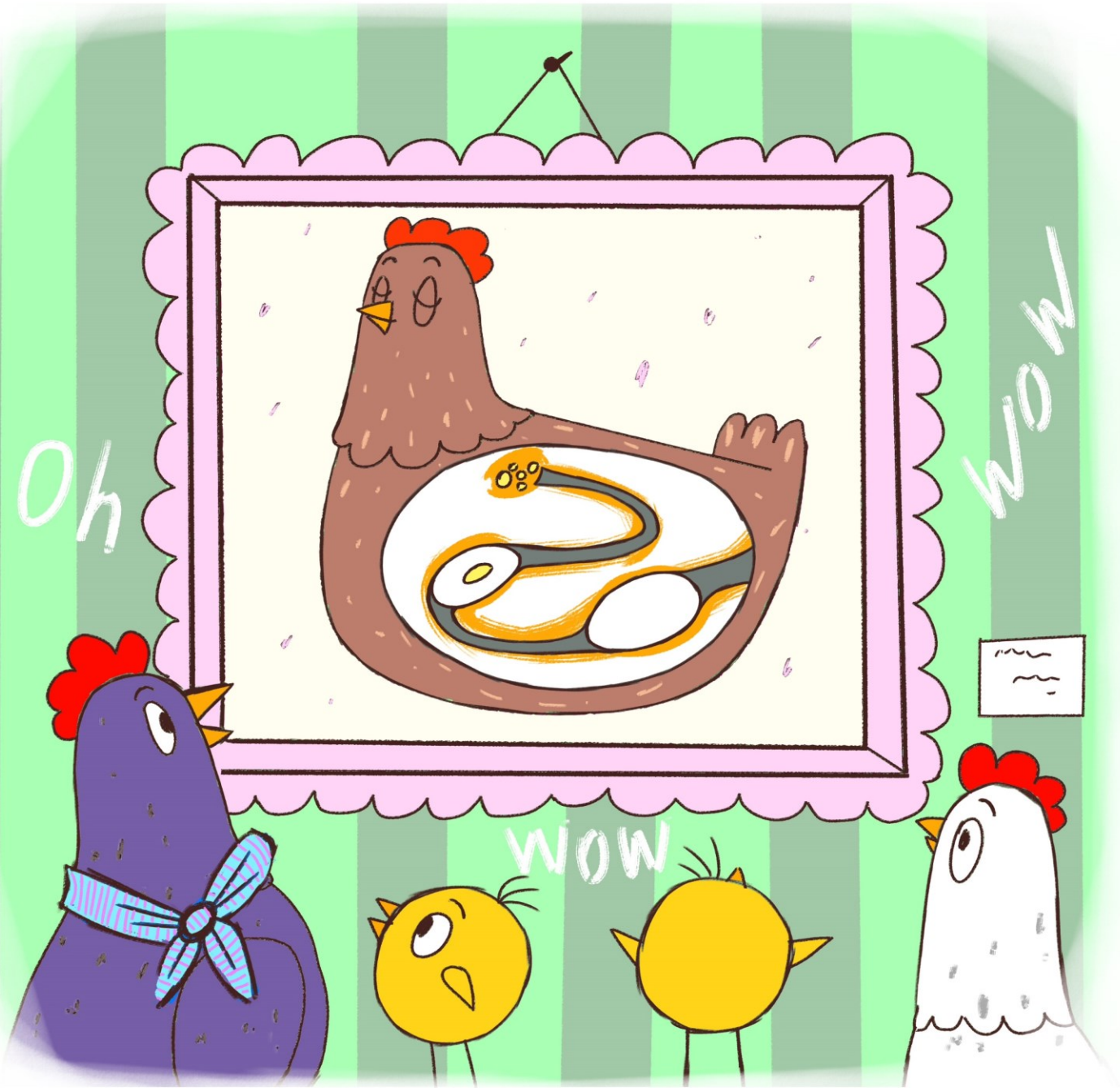

- ◇ A group of chickens is called a flock

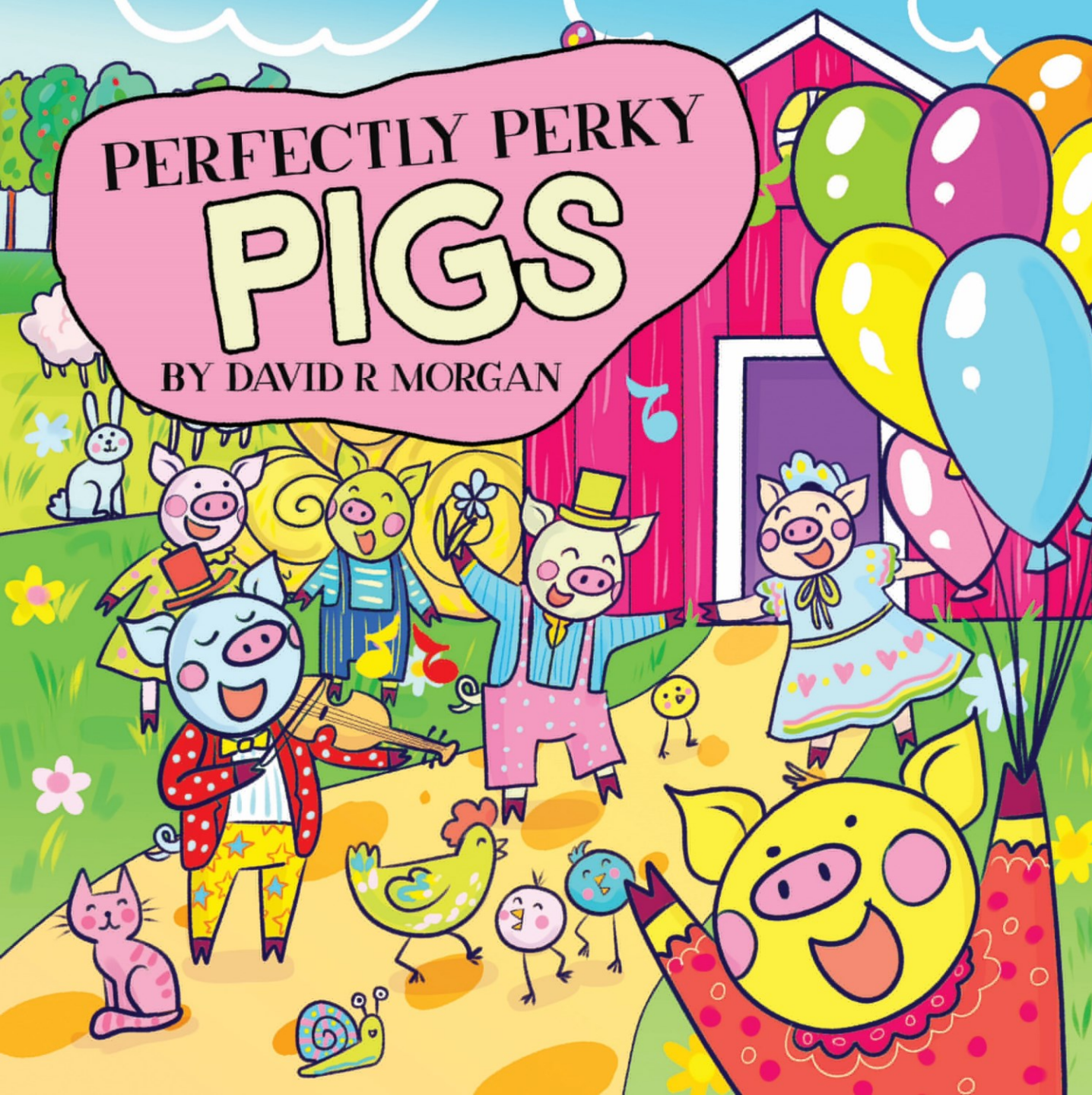

Now pigs are good and kind and rather clean,



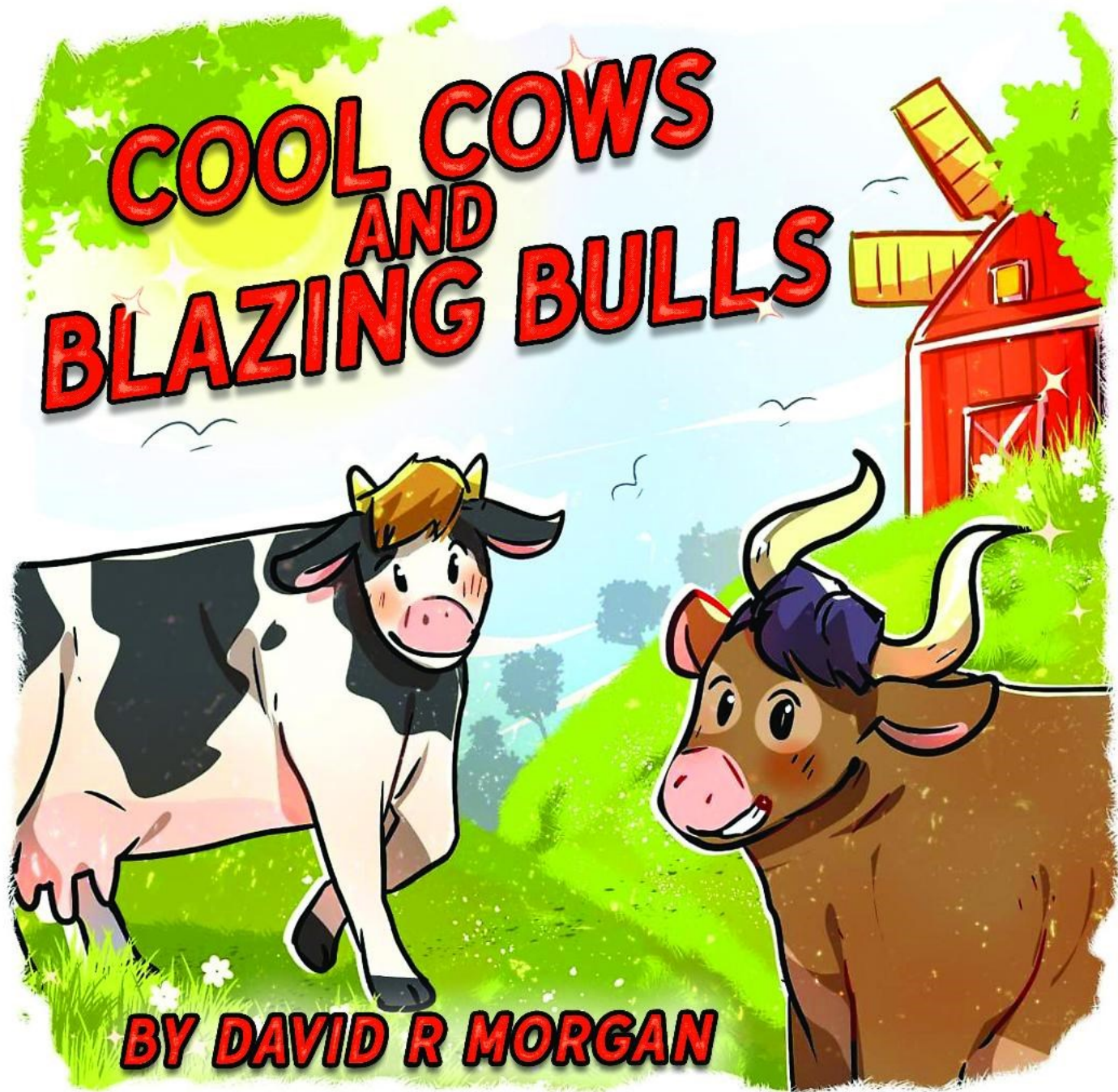
**Pigs** - are domestic animals. Some fun facts about them include:

Sri Lanka and Nepal.



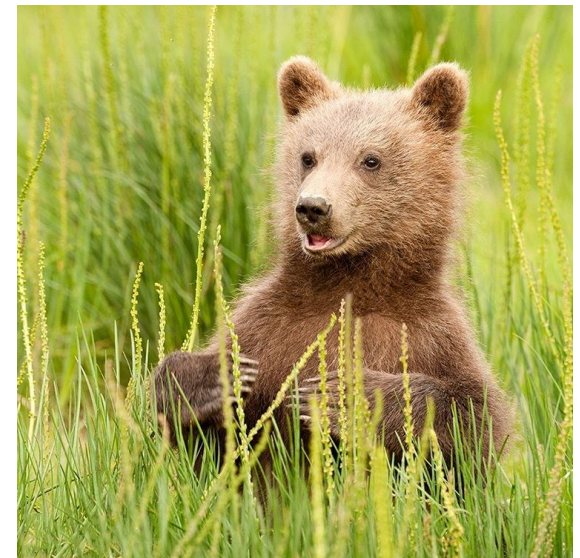
## ***Fun Facts About Bears :***
