
These delightful stories are educational and entertaining children's stories that are clever - they educate, help with reading skills and are great fun for children of all ages. Come see the stories!



Cheeky Chickens is a sweet and fun little book about - you guessed it chickens! Come, see how the hens and roosters and chicks have fun in the barnyard.





Now pigs are good and kind and rather clean,


And it's a well-known FACT that they are truly very clean! No matter what bad reviews they get.

This liquid cow juice is creamy and smooth as sweet silk


The cow and the bull, with their long horns, Are of high value as soon as they're born.



There are Hereford, Angus, Holstein, and Highland,






Beamingly brilliant bears love honey made by bees,
